DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded October 31, 1958. 95' of 8 1/8" surface casing set at 105' with 200 sacks cement. Tested for 30 minutes with 700 lbs. pressure, no leaks. Drilled cement plug November 1, 1958. Tested for 30 minutes with 700 lbs. pressure, no drop in pressure.
