You have recently inquired about necessary information to be filed on gas well workovers.

By our rules it is necessary that you file either Form C 103 or Form C-104 giving details of the workover. After the well has been re-connected a State deliverability test should be submitted within 45 days showing the new deliverability. We will then assign a gas supplement correcting the allowable to the date of re-connection or to date 45 days prior to date of receipt of the deliverability test, whichever is later.

I believe all you lack on your McCoy Unit well in order to re-assign an allowable is the deliverability test.
