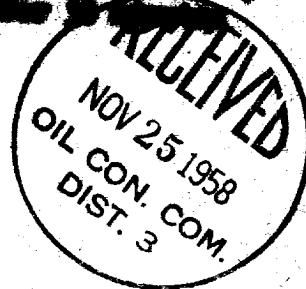

DETAILS OF WORK
