



THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL  
& GAS, INC., FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1274

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 9, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Duke Well No. 1-13 located in Unit H of Section 13, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools.

Now, on this 29th day of January, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be, and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Duke Well No. 1-13 located in Unit H of Section 13, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

OR BY 11-11-63

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-1, Commission Order 11-1, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 9, 1963, for permission to drill complete in the Duke Well No. 1-11 located in Unit 8 of Section 18, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, T14N, R13W, San Juan County, New Mexico, to such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Maverick and Basin-Gascon pools.

Now, on this 11th day of January, 1963, the Secretary  
Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil and gas wells have been duly notified, and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause adverse or injurious competitive effects.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Gas & Oil, Inc., and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete in the Duke Well No. 1-11 located in Unit 8 of Section 18, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, T14N, R13W, San Juan County, New Mexico, to such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Maverick and Basin-Gascon pools, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-1.

EXHIBIT ATTACHED. That applicant shall have proper leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Well Completion Test Period for the Basin-Gascon Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
