Dear Gary:

As requested by Dianna Fairhurst or myself between July 19 and August 31, the bradenheads were dug out on the referenced wells. An inspection conducted by myself on 10-5-93, revealed that although the Seymour #7 and the SJU 32-9 #23 have intermediate casing, the wellhead configuration prohibits testing the intermediate casing and long string independently. The existing tests will be accepted and the wells need not be retested. The Brookhaven Com A #2 does have three casing spools. The 9 5/8" surface pipe spool is imbedded in cement but the valve is in an open position. Plumbing it to the surface and retesting it will be sufficient. Our kardex files indicated a full string of 5 1/2" casing on the SJU 32-9 #30. A review of our well file by myself and Steve Stamets revealed this was in error and the well has a hung liner. The existing test is sufficient and the well need not be retested.

Thank you and your crew for your timely and efficient response to our requests.
