DETAILS OF WORK

Well Spudded 8-7-60.  
Drilled 1 1/2" hole to 217' set 10-3/4" 22.75 lb/ft casing at 110' with 100 sacks cement with full returns. Pressured casing to 500' for 30 min. with no drop in pressure. After cement set plug was drilled and B.S.P. closed and casing pressured to 500' for 30 min. with no appreciable drop in pressure. Drilling ahead resumed.
