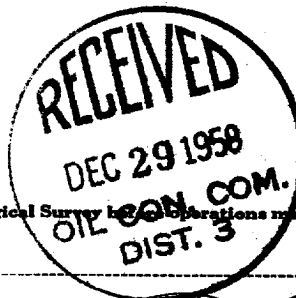

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Well spudded September 24, 1958.
2. Ran 3 joints 9-5/8", H-40, 32.3' surface casing on September 24, 1958. Casing landed at 106 ft. R.K.B. Cemented w/80 sacks regular w/20% Calcium chloride.
3. Drilled plug and pressured up to 500 psi on surface casing - pressure held.
