Gentlemen:

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Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Ute Indian Well No. 1, located 919 feet from the South line and 1268 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 31 North, Range 15 West, Verdi Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
