

DETAILS OF WORK

Run & set 7" casing at 2367' w/Halliburton IW tool set at 1353'. Cemented 1st stage around shoe w/90 sks. reg. cement & 90 sks. poxmix w/1/2 floccals per sk. WOC 6 hrs. & run temperature survey & found top of cement behind 7" casing at 1864'. Cemented 2nd stage thru IW tool at 1353' w/75 sks. reg. cement & 75 sks. poxmix 2 1/2 gal. Run temperature survey on 2nd stage & found top of cement behind 7" casing at 785'.
