Notice submitted in compliance with letter of December 6 from Ernest Cardona, copy attached.

B-M-G is determined to return this well to production as soon as practicable. To do this, we are doing the following things:

1. We have instructed our gas marketer to arrange with Williams Field Service marketing of the gas.
2. We have made a verbal agreement with Williams Field Service to obtain the necessary right-of-way - and they are authorized to use the authority under our lease to expedite it.
3. Depending on availability of equipment, we have agreed with Williams that either Williams will lay the necessary reconnecting pipeline and bill us for the cost or we will do this construction ourselves.
4. Williams is scheduled to determine the location of the tie-in December 10, 1996.
5. Bradenhead test will be conducted prior to December 24, 1996.

Dear Mr. Greer:

Frank Chavez received your letter dated November 26, 1996. After discussion of your letter on the above referenced well, we determined the following requirements will have to be met before an extension is allowed on the deadline for bringing this well into compliance:

1. The well will have to have a Bradenhead Test conducted on it and witnessed by someone from our office before December 24, 1996.
2. A Sundry Notice (C-103) must be submitted to our office on or before January 1, 1997. This sundry must state what B-M-G is determined to do in order to bring the A Gross #1 into compliance (well returned to production, TA or P&A), with a complete description of the work to be done. All work must be completed on or before March 1, 1997, in order for this well to be considered in compliance.
