

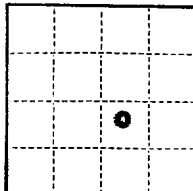

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded April 30, 1957. Set 94' of 8 5/8" casing at 106' with 90 sacks cement. Tested for 30 minutes with 500 lbs. pressure, no drop in pressure. Cement plug drilled May 1, 1957.
