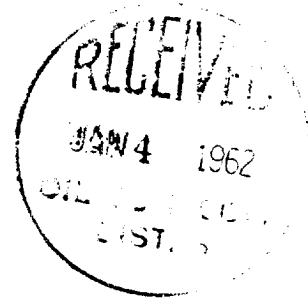

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Segal Well No. 1-10 to be located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of said Section 10, which is to be dually completed in each of the above-mentioned formations.

You are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
