

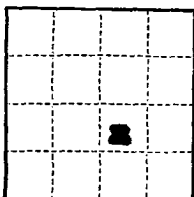

## DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 9-5/8" hole at 4:00 P.M., 6/12/59. Set 7-1/8" casing at 45' w/10 sacks reg. cement. Drilled w/air to 925' & mudded up. Ran elec. logs, 925' to 945' FMS. Set 5" CD casing at 945' w/70 sacks 15 sacks cement. Pumped plug down w/200 gals. MCA & oil. Ran Gamma Ray & collar logs. Perforated from 925' to 928' w/2 jet shots per foot. Sand/oil flow w/20,000 gals. 100. crabs, 30,000' sand & 120 gals. 1-99. Ave. inj. rate 18 bbls./min. at 925'. Moved in unit & changed out mud. Set 5" tubing at 925'. Ran rods & pump and set pumping unit. On final 24 hour potential test on 15-30" SWF pumped 60 bbls. more FMS. Gov. Gr. 39.3. First saw oil to tank 7/1/59.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
