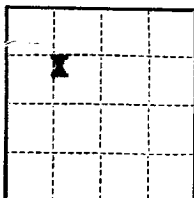

DETAILS OF WORK

Ute Mountain Tribal "D" Well No. 1 was spudded on February 21, 1958, and on February 23, 1958, 13-3/8" casing was set at 400' with 530 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 800 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
