



DETAILS OF WORK

The Federal 12-8 #1 was spudded at 1:00 AM 5/9/59. 13-3/8" surface pipe was set at 163' with 150 sx neat cement. Cement was circulated to surface. After 24 hours the pipe was tested with 400 psi water pressure and found to have no leaks. Presently the well is drilling ahead in 12 1/4" hole at a depth of 3090'.
