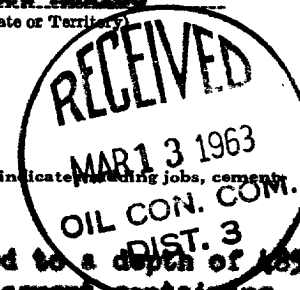

DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was spudded on February 28, 1963 and was drilled to a depth of 125'. 19-3/8" casing was set at that depth with 500 sacks Class "C" cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated cement to surface. After waiting on cement, tested casing to 400 psi for 30 minutes. Test ok. Reduced hole to 12-1/4" and resumed drilling.
