DETAILS OF WORK

The above wells drilled to a total depth of 3632'. As a result of failing to find oil or gas in commercial quantities, we propose to plug and abandon this well as follows:

1. 100 sacks plug from 3150' to 3000'.
2. 100 sacks plug from 1470' to 1370'.
3. 100 sacks plug from 1100' to 1000'.
4. 50 sacks plug from 510' to 460'.
5. 50 sacks plug from 16' to surface.
6. Erect abandonment marker and clean up location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
