DETAILS OF WORK

Spotted 7-7/8" hole at 4:30 P.M., 6/24/59. Set 7-7/8" casing at 40' w/ 100 lb. cement. Drilled water to 1250' & mudged up. Run elec. logs. 1150' to 1250' sec. Set 3" casing at 1150' w/ 75 lb. cement. Pumped plug down with 200 gal. oil & air. Run Gamma Ray & Collar logs. Forwarded from 1150' to 1250' w/ 100 gal. per foot. Sand/oil flow w/ 100,000 gal. low. credit and 30,000' sand. Ave. inj. rate 14.5 bbls./min. at 2750'. Moved in with & cement sand from 1150' to 1250'. Set 3" tubing at 1250'. Run rods & pump & set pumping unit. On final 24 hour potential test on 12-20" API pumped at 14.5 bbls. per min. over 24 hrs. First new production oil to tanks 7/1/59.
