Reference is made to your application for approval of a 315.58-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Dusenbury Well No. 3 located 1830 feet from the South line and 1075 feet from the East line of said Section 1.

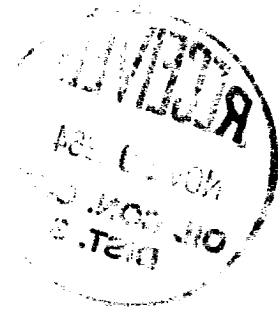
