DETAILS OF WORK

Perforated 4" CD casing with 2 jet shots per foot from 1078' to 1094'. Spotted 200 gal. MCA on perforations. Drills to 2000'. Sand-oil fraced with 20,000 gal. crude oil and 30,000' sand. Avg. inj. rate of 29.5 bbls. per min. at 1200'. (SI press. after 5 mins. 2750'.) Now preparing to install pumping equipment and recover lead oil.
