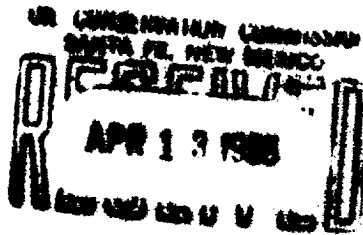

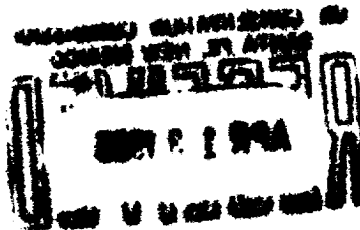
Gentlemen:

Astec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the West Half (1/2), (or SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Lots 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7), of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Astec ~~at all-Dusenberry~~ No. 1 Well, located 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, was completed September 3, 1951 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on September 14, 1951.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 310.92 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. So far as is known to Applicant, the following company constitutes the only operator, other than Applicant, owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and such company is being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to it:

As set forth in the application, the applicant is requesting approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the West 1/4 of Section 3, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., of Section 6, Township 1 N., Range 11 West, S. 1 E. P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the well at ~~the intersection of the West 1/4 of Section 3, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., of Section 6, Township 1 N., Range 11 West, S. 1 E. P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof~~ was completed September 1, 1951, as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on September 1, 1951.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas production unit consists of 210.92 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
