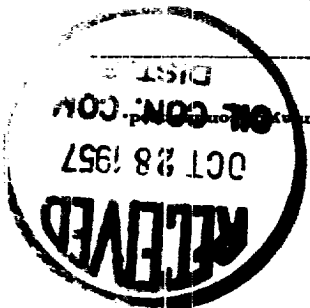

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
The name of this well was changed from the Houston Field 571 to H-571. The well was spudded on 9-9-57. Surface casing (13 1/8") was set at 375 feet and intermediate casing (9 5/8") was set at 1000 feet w/ 200 ft cement. IS induction and logging were run at 1900 feet before running 9 5/8" casing. On the last day of the month operation was drilling 8 1/2" hole at 6000 feet.

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5600 ft.

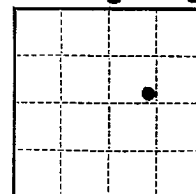
