DETAILS OF WORK

Notice is hereby given of intention to plug and abandon the Navajo-Ute 691. Perforations in the 9 5/8" casing from 1718' to 1734' will be squeezed off w/ 50 sacks of cement. A 20' cement plug will be spotted in the top of the casing w/ a 10 ft. piece of 4" line pipe standing in the casing w/ 4' above ground level. A sign showing the location of the hole will be set near the 4" pipe.
