THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL & GAS, INC., FOR A DUAL COMPLETION. ORDER NO. MC-1199

INVESTIGATION ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 6, 1962, for permission to dually complete its Baird Well No. 1-4 located in Unit H, Section 4, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

Now, on this 28th day of June, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Baird Well No. 1-4 located in Unit H, Section 4, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Deliverability Test period for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the



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Commission may deem necessary.
