On February 20, 1957 this office received a copy of a letter written to your Company by Mr. Murray E. Morgan, Commissioner of Public Lands regarding a communitization of the East half of Section 2-31N-13W. Mr. Morgan stated at that time that the South half of the SE quarter of this section is State acreage in lease #E-3150. The record owner on this assignment being El Paso Natural Gas Company. He also stated that this acreage had not been communitized and that until the communitization was completed the 80 acres would not be included for a 320-acre allowable.

Based upon this information we have held your Form C-110, Authorization to Transport form pending notification of communitization.
