Perforations: 1294-1304' w/2 holes/ft.
Frac Treated: Attempted to treat 2/12, 8000' 20-40 sand and 9000' 10-20 sand in 6000 gals. crude oil. Spearheaded w/1200 gals. oil w/2 1/2 gals. Hunkies. Pump down from 1400' to 1200'. Followed w/sand when 9000' 20-40 sand in formation sand out. Injection rate 25 BPM, average @ 1400'. Injection pressure 1600' max. SI press. 800'.

Completed 6-23-63 as an oil well pumping 170 bbls. oil and no water in 2 1/2 hours thru open choke. GP 20', TP 20', estimated GOR 360. Gravity 41.0 corrected.
