DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 7, 1953, 7" casing was landed at 4627 feet and cemented with 420 sacks of cement. Plug down at 1:32 A.M., August 8, 1953. At 1:30 A.M., August 10, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1250 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Two hundred and 11 feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1250 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
