**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

The well was spudded at 3:30 P.M., June 27, 1953. On June 28, 1953, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 256 feet and cemented with 200 sacks of cement. Cement plug down at 10:30 A.M., June 28, 1953. At 10:30 A.M., June 29, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. Forty-three feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes.

There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
