

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. This well is an open hole, nitroglycerine completion. It is proposed to sidetrack, redrill, case, and fracture complete the Mesaverde formation according to the plan below:

1. A cement plug has already been set from 4755'-4598'.
2. Set a CIBP at 4500'.
3. Perforate 7" casing @ 3150' and circulate cement to surface (340 sxs).
4. Run GR/CBL/CCL across proposed sidetrack interval and from 3150' and up.
5. Set whipstock and mill window @ 4350'.
6. Drill 6-1/4" hole with air to 5764'.
7. Run 4-1/2 casing from 5764' to surface and cement up to 3450' with 160 sxs cement.
8. Cut off 4-1/2" casing @ 3450'.
9. Perforate selected Mesaverde intervals and fracture stimulate.
10. Return well to production.

Copies of this "intent" to sidetrack the Suter 1X have been sent by certified mail (as indicated by the attached mail receipts) to all offset operators as required by NMOC regulations concerning sidetracked holes.
