It is intended to workover the subject well in order to shut off the gas and water seepage from around the wellhead. The work will be conducted so as to place cement across the entire Ojo Alamo interval and to cement the 4 1/2" csg to surface. Operations will begin after the TOC is found by running a CBL. Perforating, squeezing, and logging operations will then commence and will not be suspended until the previously mentioned objectives are met.
