Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 1 ~~BLM~~ Mexico-Federal R, sec. 12, Township ~~31~~ 31 N., R. 13 W., San Juan County, lease No. New Mexico 080280.

On January 5, 1981, a letter was sent to you stating that the Application to Drill the above well was terminated due to drilling operations not being commenced within one year of the approval date. On January 19, 1981, we received from your office a Sundry Notice stating the well was spudded on October 12, 1980.

The stipulations attached to your approved Application state Sundry Notices are to be submitted to this office within 15 days after the work is completed. Your Sundry Notice was received approximately 93 days after the work was completed, and only after you received notice of its termination. This is a serious violation of our reporting requirements, and can result in the assessment of liquidated damages.

The termination of an approved Application involved its complete removal from our files, and subsequent notification to a number of other state/Federal/Indian agencies. As such, you are hereby notified to submit to this office the following:

1. The Approved copy of your Application, including the attached stipulations, sent to you with our January 7, 1981 letter.
2. Four copies of the above Application, which will be forwarded to the appropriate State and Federal Agencies.
3. One copy of the Archaeological Report prepared for this location.

This information is to be provided to this office by February 1, 1981.
