Unorthodox Gas Well Location
Leeper Gas Com #2
Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool
San Juan County, New Mexico

Standard drilling locations in the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool must be 130 feet from the interior edge and 790 feet from the exterior edge of each quarter section.

Amoco is having difficulty finding a suitable location to drill its Leeper Gas Com #2 as a Pictured Cliffs test in the SW/4 of Section 34-T32N-R10W. Steep sided bluffs and the river that courses generally north-south through this quarter section make it advisable for Amoco to seek your administrative approval to drill the Leeper Gas Com #2 at an unorthodox location 1850 feet FWL and 820 feet FSL of Section 34 (please see the attached plat). We have archaeological clearance from the BLM for the requested unorthodox location.

The unorthodox move is slightly towards El Paso Natural Gas, operator of the Scott #19 Well in SW/4 SE/4 Section 34, in which Amoco has an interest. By copy of this letter, we request that El Paso sign in the space provided that they have no objection to this unorthodox well location in the SW/4 of Section 34, sending one signed copy to you, returning one copy to me and retaining the third copy for their internal needs.



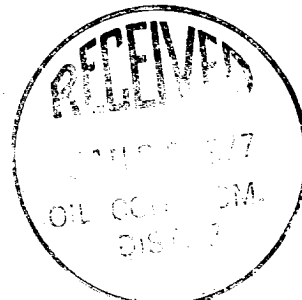
