Surface set: 12-11-76 - 8 5/8" 24# Csg. set @ 530' with 285 Sx. of Class "B" cement with 3% CaCl & circulated to surface. 8 5/8" Csg. tested to 650# & held steady for 5 min.

Air drilled a 6 1/4" hole from under surface to approx. depth of 2313 feet and converted to mud and drilled on to T.D. of 2559' (6 1/4" hole). Reached T.D. 12-20-76, ran logs and then on 12-21-76 set 2559' of 4 1/2" 10.23# Csg. cemented with 160 sacks of 50-50 Posmix. - 4 1/2" Csg. tested to 1500# and held steady of 5 min.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
