Amoco Production Company has modified the subject well as follows: on 9/2/87, a blind plate was installed at the surface to prevent gas sales. All production equipment associated with the Fruitland Coal was dismantled. Amoco is using the well as a pressure monitor well for the Fruitland Coal. If the well shall no longer be used as a pressure monitor well, the coal horizon will be plugged and abandoned at that time. From this point forward the Pritchard C #1 (1430' FNL, 1540' FEL) will become the producing well for the coal horizon for the 320 spacing unit.
