This is to request a deliverability retest for the above well.

According to the records received from Meridian Oil, the well's deliverability for the test run 10-21-84 to 10-29-84 was 1,164 MCFD. When Tenneco took over operations of this well on 9-5-85, production was averaging 1.6 MMCFD w/20 BOPD. Tenneco then worked the well over, pulling the 2-3/8" tubing, and installing a larger, less restricting wellhead and more surface separation. The well is now flowing 8.94 MMCFD and 1,093 BOPD.

We request the retest be approved as soon as possible to prevent the well from being overproduced. Please call if you have any questions.
