Under the provisions of Rule 112-A El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 23, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Hutchin Well No. 1A located in Unit P of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.


