

THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHLAND ROYALTY  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2751

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southland Royalty Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 12, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Burnt Mesa Well No. 1A located in Unit J of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Los Pinos Fruitland-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 2nd day of December, 1980, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Burnt Mesa Well No. 1A located in Unit J of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Los Pinos Fruitland-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.


PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage ~~and~~ ~~propose~~ completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.





NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.


