8/6/86 MIRUSU. Blow down well. Kill w/ 2% KCL. NDWH, NUBOP. Tally, pick up and RIH with 1-1/4" drillpipe openended. Tag the fill at 3068', 21' of perforations covered. POOH. RIH with drillpipe and RBP. Set the plug at 2804'. POOH. RIH with drillpipe and pkr. Set the pkr 1 jt above the BP. PT to 1000 psi, ok. Come up hole and isolated leak. Bottom is 2003'. Top of leak @ 1883'. POOH with drillpipe and pkr. SDON.

SJU 32-9 #91

8/7/86 RIH with drillpipe, casing scraper and drag bit. NDBOP, NUWH. Pump 1 sx sand on top of BP and allow to settle. Broke circulation down 2-7/8 csg and out bradenhead. Mix 150 sx of RFC 12.2 cement. Circ 40 BBLS out behind casing. Closed bradenhead. Displaced cmt within 50' of hole. Max Pressure 700 psi. SDON. Waiting on cement.

8/8/86 RIH w/bit, casing scraper and drillpipe. Drilled out squeeze. PT to 1000 psi. Lost about 300# in 3 minutes. Circulate hole clean. POOH with drillpipe, bit and casing scraper. RIH with drillpipe & retrieving head. CO to top of RBP with foam. Released BP. POOH with BP and drillpipe. RIH with drillpipe and bit. CO to PBTD with foam. POOH with drillpipe and bit laying down. NDBOP, NUWH. RDMOSU.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
