

THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHLAND ROYALTY  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2472

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southland Royalty Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 16, 1978, for permission to dually complete its Harrison Well No. 2 located in Unit K of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation and from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now, on this 6th day of November, 1978, the Division Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Harrison Well No. 2 located in Unit K of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation and from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
