

Dear Mr. White:

Reference is made to your application of February 27, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Johnston Federal Well No. 16 located 820 feet from the North line and 1040 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 33, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 33 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
