

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain work operations and reports on the operations. Such proposals are submitted on the part of the contractor pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and if approved or approved by any State, by the contractor, and by the State, pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form are contained in the pages to be completed. When preparing local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local, area, or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal Regulations 25.103(a) and 25.103(b).

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonments should include the specific location for the well, the name of the owner, and the location of the wellhead. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment, with an indication of whether the well is a potential significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement; casing, tubing, and/or liner; and other relevant data; and plugs; amount, size, method of placing of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the well; location of casing top of well; and date well was conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
