### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Southland Royalty Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on August 25, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Davis Well No. 7E located in Unit L of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation and from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 5th day of September, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Davis Well No. 7E located in Unit L of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation and from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.



DAVIS #7E 1520' FSL & 790' FWL San Juan County, NM Basin Dakota/Undes. Fruitland




