

PLUG AND ABANDONMENT PROCEDURE:

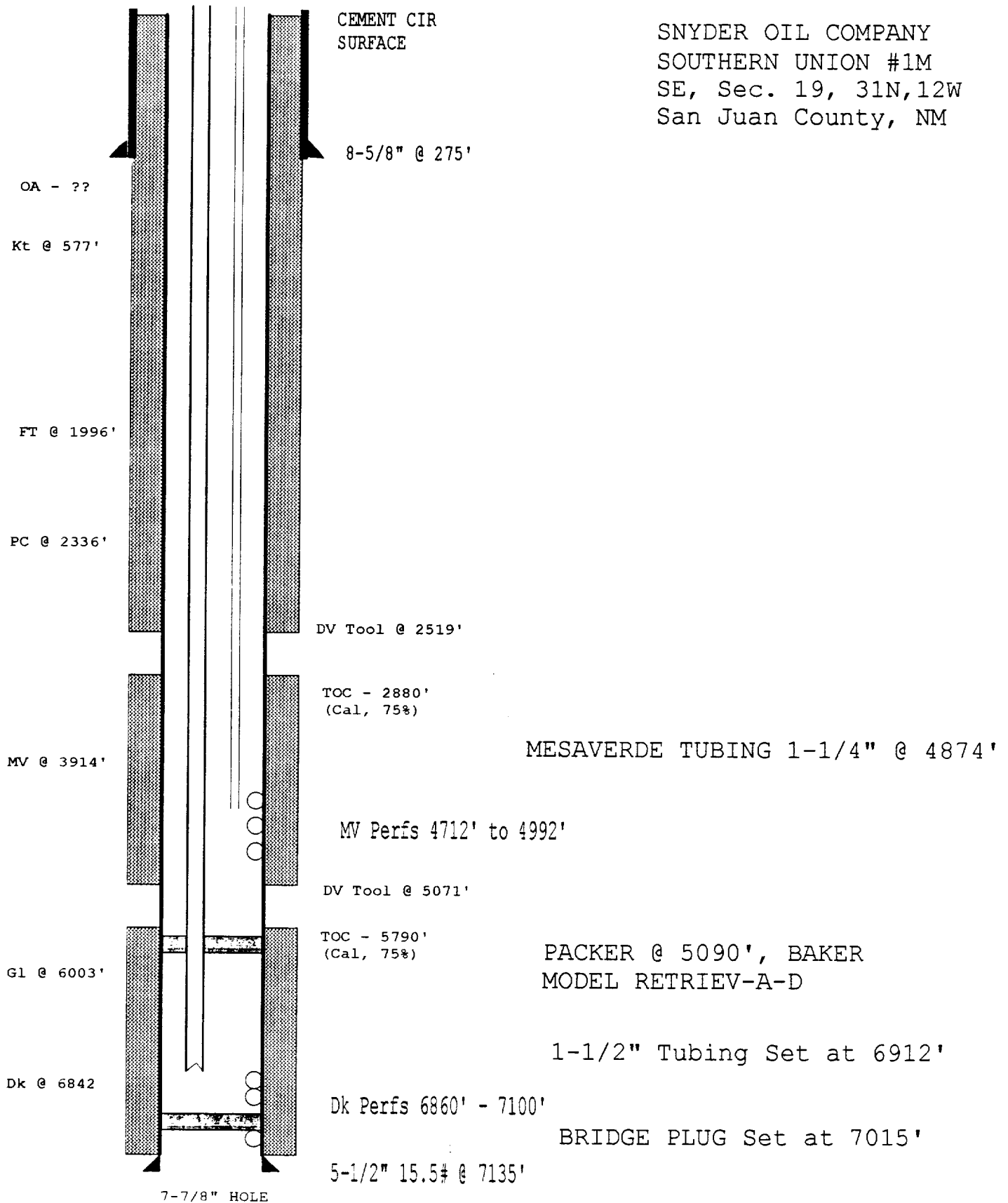
Dakota Zone Only

1. MOL and RUSU. Comply to all NMOC, BLM and Snyder safety rules and regulations.
2. Blow well down; kill with water if necessary; a 8.3 ppg wellbore fluid exceeds the exposed reservoir's pressure. ND wellhead and NU BOP and stripping head; test BOP.
3. NU offset spool; POH with 1-1/4 Mesaverde tubing and LD; change over for 1-1/2" tubing; release seal assembly from Baker Retrieval-D packer at 5090'; POH with 1-1/2" Dakota tubing and LD seal assembly.
4. PU 5-1/2" cement retainer and 2" tubing work string if necessary. RIH and set CR at 5080' (above packer, Gallup top and Dakota perfs); pressure test tubing to 1000#; establish rate into Dakota perfs.
5. Plug #1 under CR at 5080' to 7015' with 250 sxs Class B cement (10% excess, long plug), squeeze 245 sxs below CR then spot 5 sxs on top. POH to 5000'.
6. Unload well with nitrogen and blow clean. POH to 4900' and land tubing. ND BOP and NU wellhead. Rig down and move off location.
