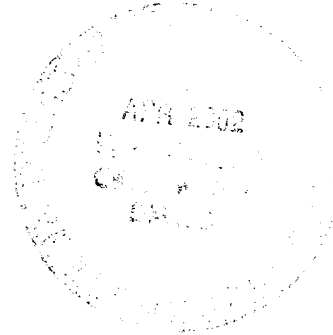


The above referenced well is a Mesaverde/Dakota commingle. Attached is a copy of the allocation for the commingling of the subject well completed on June 5, 2001. DHC-209az was issued for this well.

Gas:	Mesa Verde	10%
	Dakota	90%

Oil:	Mesa Verde	0%
	Dakota	100%

These percentages are based upon reserves assigned to each formation founded on production from the respective formations before and after workover operations. Because condensate production did not change after the Mesaverde formation was added, the oil allocation has been assigned completely to the Dakota formation.
