Gentlemen:

On June 3, 1981, we approved your Intent to Temporarily Abandon well No. 147 Navajo F located 80' FNL and 2580' FWL of sec. 9, T. 31 N., R. 17 W., San Juan County, New Mexico on Navajo Tribal lease 14-20-603-2034. The Intent was approved with the proviso that you place a wellhead on this well.

To date, we have not received your Subsequent Report of Temporary Abandonment. Within 15 days of your receipt of this letter, please submit this report stating where the bridge plug was set and that a wellhead was placed on this well if it was, in fact, temporarily abandoned.

If you have not temporarily abandoned this well, then within 60 days of receipt of this letter, you must submit a Notice of Intent to permanently plug and abandon the well with operations to plug and abandon this well to commence upon approval of the Notice of Intent.
