
Dear Sir:

My records show that on September 11, 1980, I inspected, well location Ute B #16, which was staked, 2035 FSL - FEL of Section 31, Township 31 North, Range 15 West, N.M.P.M. and found it acceptable from our standpoint.

My inspection consisted of checking for site suitability to prevent or resist erosion; interference with livestock operations; absence of adverse environmental impacts in the area; amount of area disturbed; trees or vegetation removed; and general effect of range management on Tribal lands.

Well spacing and location is the responsibility of the State and sub-surface responsibilities are controlled by U.S.G.S. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that all matters relating to leased land should be referred to Mrs. Taylor or Mr. Van Dover of the Bureau Realty Branch at this Agency. 1. *Phragmites australis* (Cav.) Trin. ex Steud. (Common reed)

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
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
