It was brought to my attention that one of the well locations in the above-named report was incorrectly plotted along with the nearby site, SJC-657.

At the time of the survey a surveyor's plat was not provided and footages had not been finalized. A field reconnaissance was conducted by me, and the well and site are in similar situation to that at the time of the initial inspection. The site was sufficiently distant from the well location and has not been impacted by activities associated with the well.

I requested copies of the field notes made by Mr. Don Englishman, U.S. Geological Survey, and those are enclosed also. As you can see, the well location was an adequate distance so as not to disturb the site. A corrected topographic map is also enclosed.

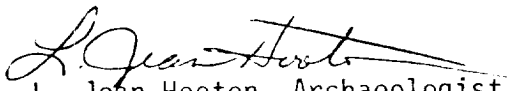
Listed below are the corrections in the legal description for the well location and Site SJC-657 (LA 27678).

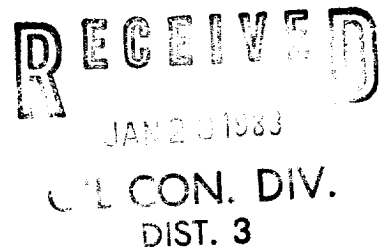
