Conditions of Approval

1. Notify this office at least 24 hours prior to commencing plugging operations.
2. Either (a) perforate the 5 1/2" casing at 150 feet and circulate cement to surface or (b) place at least 50 feet of cement within the 5 1/2" - 8 5/8" annulus at surface.
3. Remove all equipment and trash from the well-site.
4. Fill in all existing pits and contour well-site to existing land form.
5. Seed existing area in accordance with Application for Permit to Drill approved October 24, 1980. Abandonment marker shall comply with the approved APD.
