13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to workover the subject well in the following manner:

A CIBP will be set 50' above the end of the 7" casing. A whipstock will be run in hole on 3 1/2" DP and set on top of the CIBP. A window will be milled and drilled out to original Fruitland Coal TD of 3240'. The hole will then be cleaned out and a 5 1/2" 15.5# K-55 preperfd liner will be re-run. The well will then be returned to production.
