MIRU Key Energy #53. Spud 12-1/4" hole @ 0300 hrs 10/5/00. Drilled to 240'. Circ. hole. COOH. RIH w/9-5/8" 32.3#, H-40 casing and set @ 234'. RU to cement. Pumped 10 bbls mud clean, 10 bbls FW w/red dye ahead of 105 sx (146 cf - 26 bbl slurry) Type 3 cement w/2% CaCl2, 1/4#/sx Cello-flake. Dropped wood plug & displaced w/16.9 bbl FW. Plug down @ 1322 hrs. Circ. 5 bbls cement to surface. WOC.

NU BOP & choke valves and lines. PT casing, rams and manifold to 200# - 3 minutes and then 1500# - 10 minutes. Good test.

NOTE: The 9-5/8" 36# J/K-55 casing that we permitted we'd being using on this well was not available, therefore we had to use the 32.3# H-40 casing.
